



- Read by a close family member or friend
- □ Length: Typically 3-5 minutes long

- □ Elements to Include:
  - ✓ Full Name: Including maiden name if applicable.
  - Date of Birth and Date of Death: To mark their journey through life.
  - ✓ Early Life: Where they were born, early family life, education.
  - Family and Relationships: Important relationships (spouse, children, siblings, etc.), and role in family life.
  - Spiritual Life: Point of salvation and impact for Christ.
  - Career and Achievements: Key professional accomplishments or personal milestones.
  - Hobbies/Passions: What they enjoyed doing in their free time, contributions to community or causes.
  - Personal Qualities/Character: Positive traits, or very short stories that capture their essence.
  - Legacy: How they impacted others, their lasting influence, or any lasting contributions.

## **Eulogies**

- Eulogy comes from the Greek word "eulogia," which means "praise" or "commendation." It is derived from "eu" (good) and "logos" (speech or word), meaning "good words" or "praise."
- Purpose: to honor and remember the life of the deceased. It often highlights their character, achievements, and the impact they had on others.
- □ Length: Typically 3\*-5 minutes long.
- □ Usually 2 to 4 eulogies.

## Military Honors Presentation by AmVet





#### □ Elements to Include:

- Introduction: Connection/relationship to the deceased.
- Personal Memories: Short stories that reflect the deceased's character, humor, and personality.
- Character Traits: Personal description of the qualities that made the person special.
- Spiritual Impact: How you were impacted or saw others impacted for Christ by the deceased.
- Impact and Legacy: Reflections on their role within their family and among friends, and how they touched the lives of others.

- Length: Typically 3 6 minutes long (one or two songs) 90 to 180 photos.
- □ Send: Photos (labeled) and songs to CBC.



"Now when Mary came to where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet, saying to him, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in his spirit and greatly troubled. And he said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to him, "Lord, come and see." Jesus wept. So the Jews said, "See how he loved him!"" (John 11:32-36)



- Grieve with Hope
  - "But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep." (1 Thessalonians 4:13-14)



- Grieve and Trust
  - "The Lord is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works."
    (Psalm 145:17)
  - "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8-9)



- Grieve and Seek Comfort
  - From God
  - "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction..." (2 Corinthians 1:3a)
  - From Others (Don't Isolate)
  - "... we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God." (2 Corinthians 1:4b)
  - "Whoever isolates himself seeks his own desire; he breaks out against all sound judgment." (Proverbs 18:1)
